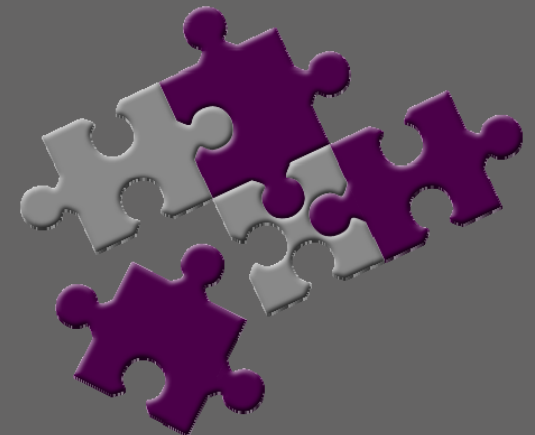

MB-PHEN was created in 2009 through a shared commitment of health regions throughout Manitoba with a goal to advance health care ethics in Manitoba through integration, collaboration and integrity.



The MB-PHEN Council is comprised of Ethics Contacts from each participating Regional Health Authority (RHA). These individuals are regional champions and resources for ethics initiatives within their respective health regions. They advise on, develop and participate in initiatives to strengthen the integration of health ethics throughout Manitoba. They promote and support ethics education and capacity development at the regional and provincial levels. They engage in annual review and periodical revision of the MB-PHEN Strategic Plan and promote and support its implementation.

Strategic goal: To work collaboratively to enhance integrative ethics capacity throughout the province. Each region will retain ownership and accountability in its capacity building efforts and initiatives through this networking opportunity.
